He also mediates disputes involving intellectual property and is on the U.S. District Court Mediation Panel List. Before becoming a lawyer, Paul was an assembly language programmer when a deck of cards was used for something more than playing poker.

Paul also represents both companies and venture capitalists in private placements and other financings.
